
The Lion King.....

The disciple Peter..

- Jesus was tried and crucified. He then came back to life again. For the next 40 days, he appeared to the disciples a few times and taught them about why he had to die on the cross.
- Just before Jesus returned to heaven, the disciples and Jesus had breakfast together on the beach. After the meal, Jesus did an amazing thing. He took Peter for a walk along the beach and made it clear that although he knew Peter had let him down, he forgave him and he still had important work for Peter to do. Having this forgiveness enabled Peter to move on with his life in a positive way. Peter ended up travelling around the Roman Empire teaching people about Jesus
