

Captain Tom is a former British Army officer
known for his achievements raising money for
charity in the run-up to his 100th birthday
during the COVID-19 pandemic.

On 6 April 2020, at the age of 99, he began to walk laps of his garden in aid of NHS Charities Together, with the goal of raising £1,000 by his hundredth birthday.

By the time he had reached the finish line, he had become a social media phenomenon and raised an astonishing £12m. By the teatime the same day, donations had risen to £15m. The total keeps growing and growing and has now passed £30m.

Marcus Rashford: Manchester United forward's campaign to mal change happen


The footballer led a successful campaign encouraging the government to offer free meals over summer.






