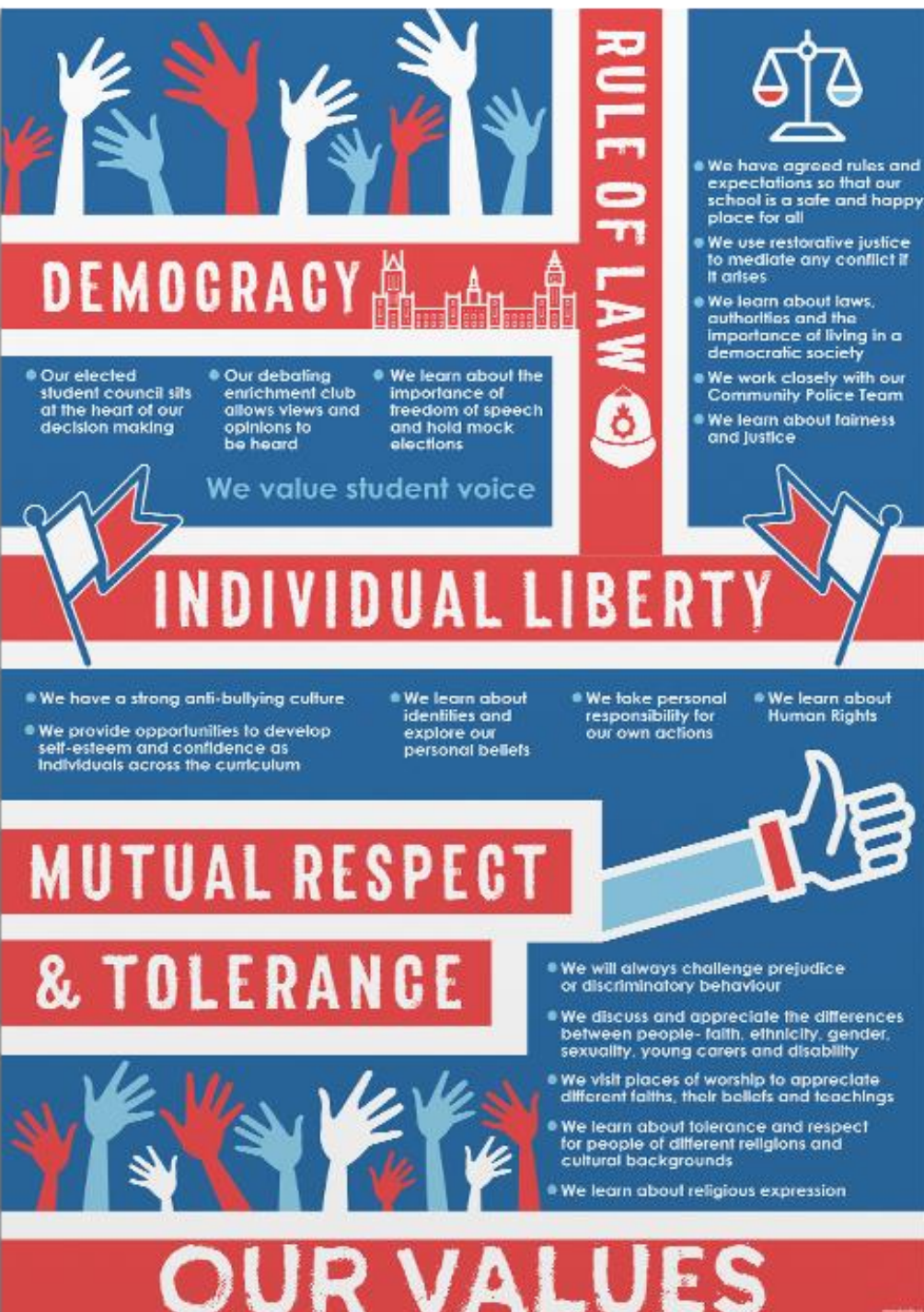
**“Carry out a random act of kindness, with no expectation of reward, safe in the knowledge that one day someone might do the same for you.”
