### The History


- Senator Gaylord Nelson, the junior senator from Wisconsin, had long been concerned about the deteriorating environment in the United States.
- Senator Nelson wanted to infuse the energy of student anti-war protests with an emerging public consciousness about air and water pollution.
- April 22<sup>nd</sup> was chosen as it fell between Spring break and final exams in America and they wanted as many college students as possible to participate
- First Earth Day took place on 22<sup>nd</sup> of April 1970 and had over 20 million Americans involved.



### The History



- Earth Day went global in 1990, mobilizing 200 million people in 141 countries and lifting environmental issues onto the world stage.
- Earth Day 1990 gave a huge boost to recycling efforts worldwide and helped pave the way for the 1992 United Nations Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro.
- By the year 2000 Earth Day was in 184 countries with 100's of millions of people taking part.

- Today, Earth Day is widely recognized as the largest secular observance in the world, marked by more than a billion people every year in over 193 countries, as a day of action to change human behaviour and create global, national and local policy changes.
- The theme for Earth Day 2022 was Invest in our Planet– a call for governments, businesses and individuals to invest in a better future for the planet.
- This year, there is also a particular focus on sustainable fashion do you know where your clothes come from? Or the impact they have on the environment?




#### Plastic, Plastic, Plastic

### Seabin Project 2019



The Seabin is a floating trash bin made from 70 to 100 percent recycled plastic. It's attached to a dock, and uses a water pump to suck water and rubbish into its interior, where rubbish and other nasty fluids can be filtered out of the water via a natural fibre bag

In a year.....



The fourth Seabin in the UK has been installed in the London's docklands to tackle litter and plastic pollution in the River Thames.

#### What can you do to help?

- Bioplastics are plastics that originate renewable biomass sources, such as vegetable fats and oils, corn starch, straw, woodchips, food waste, etc.
