- Men talk 75% of the time in meetings.
- Women can still be forced to wear heels in some jobs in the UK.
- Women can earn 25-40% less than a man doing the same job.
- 35% of countries have no regulation to prevent sexual harassment in the workplace.
- Women spend £5000 on period products in their lifetime.
- Women are statistically more likely to experience harassment or feel unsafe in public spaces.
- Women, particularly in Western cultures, often face intense pressure to conform to certain beauty standards, with estimates suggesting women spend 10–20% of their disposable income on beauty products and services.
