




# Keeping our Community Safe

- To ensure all members of our community are safe, no students are allowed on the Lower Road.
- This area is classed as Out of Bounds and any student there will be issued a C2 which is a detention with SLT on a Friday which ends at 4pm.

- To ensure that all students and staff are able to use the Library undisturbed so they can focus on reading, research and other learning activities; the balcony outside the Library is classed as Out of Bounds.
- Any student there will be issued a C2 which is a detention with SLT on a Friday which ends at 4pm.

- Any student there will be issued a C2 which is a detention with SLT on a Friday which ends at 4pm.

# Keeping our Community Safe

- To ensure the safety of our community we do not sit on the walls or the bars in case of an accident.
- This area is classed as Out of Bounds as nobody needs to be in that area and the Lower Road is Out of Bounds.



# Keeping our Community Safe

- To keep our community safe use of the field at break and lunchtime is classed as Out of Bounds.
- In the winter particularly the area can get muddy and slippery.

# Keeping our Community Safe

- To keep our community safe this area is for Y11 only and they need to stay within the last wooden bench. Any further than that is classed as Out of Bounds.
- Anyone who is not a Y11 student who is there at break and lunch time will be issued a sanction in line with our Behaviour Ladder which will be a C2.
- If you are in Y11 and in this area you must put any rubbish in the bin to keep our area clean and prevent unwanted furry visitors!

# Keeping our Community Safe

- To keep our community safe and to respect our neighbours we do not stand on the wall or the path behind the wall.
- We do not eat in this area.
- We are not allowed to play any ball games on this area. It causes damage to our buildings and impacts our neighbours.



# Keeping our Community Safe

- To keep our community safe no student should be in this area, and nobody should sit on the box.
- This is classed as an Out of Bounds Area at all times.



# Keeping our Community Safe

- All access to doors need to be kept clear in case we need to evacuate in an emergency.
- During break or lunchtimes nobody is allowed to sit on the floor or be in any of the areas behind the barrier.
- This is classed as an Out of Bounds area during break and lunch time.

# Keeping our Community Safe

- The lift is vital to many of our students who need to access classrooms upstairs.
- Only students with permission are allowed in the lift and nobody is allowed to travel in the lift by themselves.
- Therefore, the lift is classed as an Out of Bounds area for anyone who has not been given permission to use it.
- Any student without permission found in the lift will be issued a C2 which is a detention with SLT on a Friday which ends at 4pm.
