'Say, "He is Allah, [who is] One."' (Qur'an 112:1)

'Allah witnesses that there is no deity except Him ... There is no deity except Him, the Exalted in Might, the Wise.' (Qur'an 3:18)

'Do they not see that Allah, who created the heavens and earth and did not fail in their creation, is able to give life to the dead? Yes. Indeed, He is over all things competent.' (Qur'an 46:33)

'And We have already created man and know what his soul whispers to him, and We are closer to him than [his] jugular vein.' (Qur'an 50:16)

'And no bearer of burdens will bear the burden of another.' (Qur'an 35:18)

'Indeed, Allah does not forgive association with Him... And he who associates others with Allah has certainly gone far astray.' (Qur'an 4:116)

'Say, "Whoever is an enemy to Gabriel (Jabril) – it is [none but] he who has brought the Qur'an down upon your heart, [O Muhammad], by permission of Allah, confirming that which was before it and as guidance and good tidings for the believers." Whoever is an enemy to Allah and His angels and His messengers and Gabriel (Jabril) and Michael – then indeed, Allah is an enemy to the disbelievers.' (Qur'an 2:97-98)

'So exalt [Allah] with praise of your Lord and be of those who prostrate [to Him]. And worship your Lord until there comes to you the certainty (death).' (Qur'an 15:98-99)

'Recite, [O Muhammad], what has been revealed to you of the Book and establish prayer. Indeed, prayer prohibits immorality and wrongdoing, and the remembrance of Allah is greater. And Allah knows that which you do.' (Qur'an 29:45)

'Zakat expenditures are only for the poor and for the needy and for those employed to collect [zakat] and for bringing hearts together [for Islam] and for freeing captives [or slaves] and for those in debt and for the cause of Allah and for the [stranded] traveller - an obligation [imposed] by Allah. And Allah is Knowing and Wise.' (Qur'an 9:60)

'O you who have believed, decreed upon you is fasting as it was decreed upon those before you that you may become righteous.' (Qur'an 2:183)

'[Fasting for] a limited number of days. So whoever among you is ill or on a journey [during them] - then an equal number of days [are to be made up]. And upon those who are able [to fast, but with hardship] - a ransom [as substitute] of feeding a poor person [each day]. And whoever volunteers excess - it is better for him. But to fast is best for you, if you only knew.' (Qur'an 2:18)
