

## Career Talk Tuesdays



In the summer term of 2022 launched Career Talk Tuesdays for Year 11, 10 and Year 9 students. These career talks not only informed students of the various career opportunities available but also helped ignite that spark of career interest that they never knew existed!

Students were introduced to the world of media with **Cube Video**, an industry projected to grow by 30% in 2030 with video fast becoming the most popular communications channel.

Former pupil, Brad White came back into school to talk about his journey in the Space industry following his MSc in Astrophysics and employment at **European Astrotech**. Students heard how Brad was recently stationed at the Space X facility fuelling a satellite which went up on the most recent transporter mission. The space industry is growing at an unprecedented rate with many wide range job opportunities.

The **Army** discussed the 200 different careers paths within the Army from bricklayers to combat soldiers, musicians to data analysts. The RAF explained how more and more females were joining the RAF as engineers and pilots and that there are over 23 Apprenticeship roles available.



Students learned how the **NHS** employ 6000 in Bucks with many career options such as lab technicians, doctors, nurses finance, HR, business and administration. Something for everyone.
