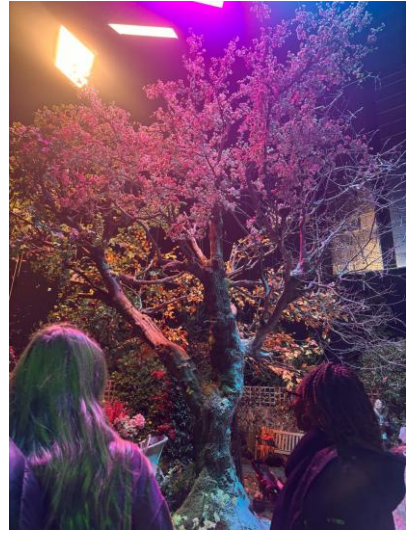


Lights, Camera, Inspiration
